STICK PEOPLE LOTTO



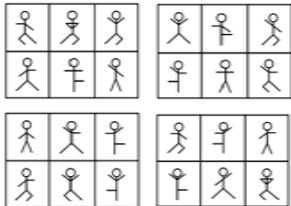
10-15 minutes



To develop self-regulation
To understand symbols: decode visual messages



- ❖ 4 lotto boards with schematic drawings - 'clever pictures'



- ❖ 24 matching posture cards



Note: This session is best done with more children or adults involved too.

Play 'Stick People Lotto':

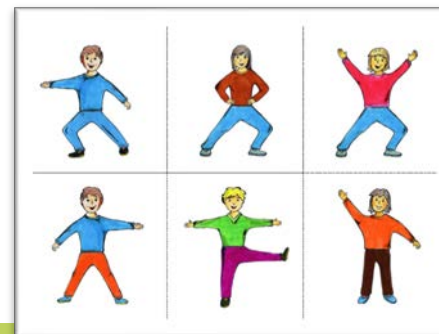
Give each player a lotto board. Point out that each board has six 'clever pictures' of body postures, but the boards are not the same.

Shuffle the 24 matching posture cards well. Take one of the them and show it to the players. Draw their attention to the position of arms, legs, head and so on, to help them to find the match.

The child with the corresponding 'clever picture' claims the card and puts it on their board covering up the 'clever picture'.

The first one to cover all six 'clever pictures' wins.

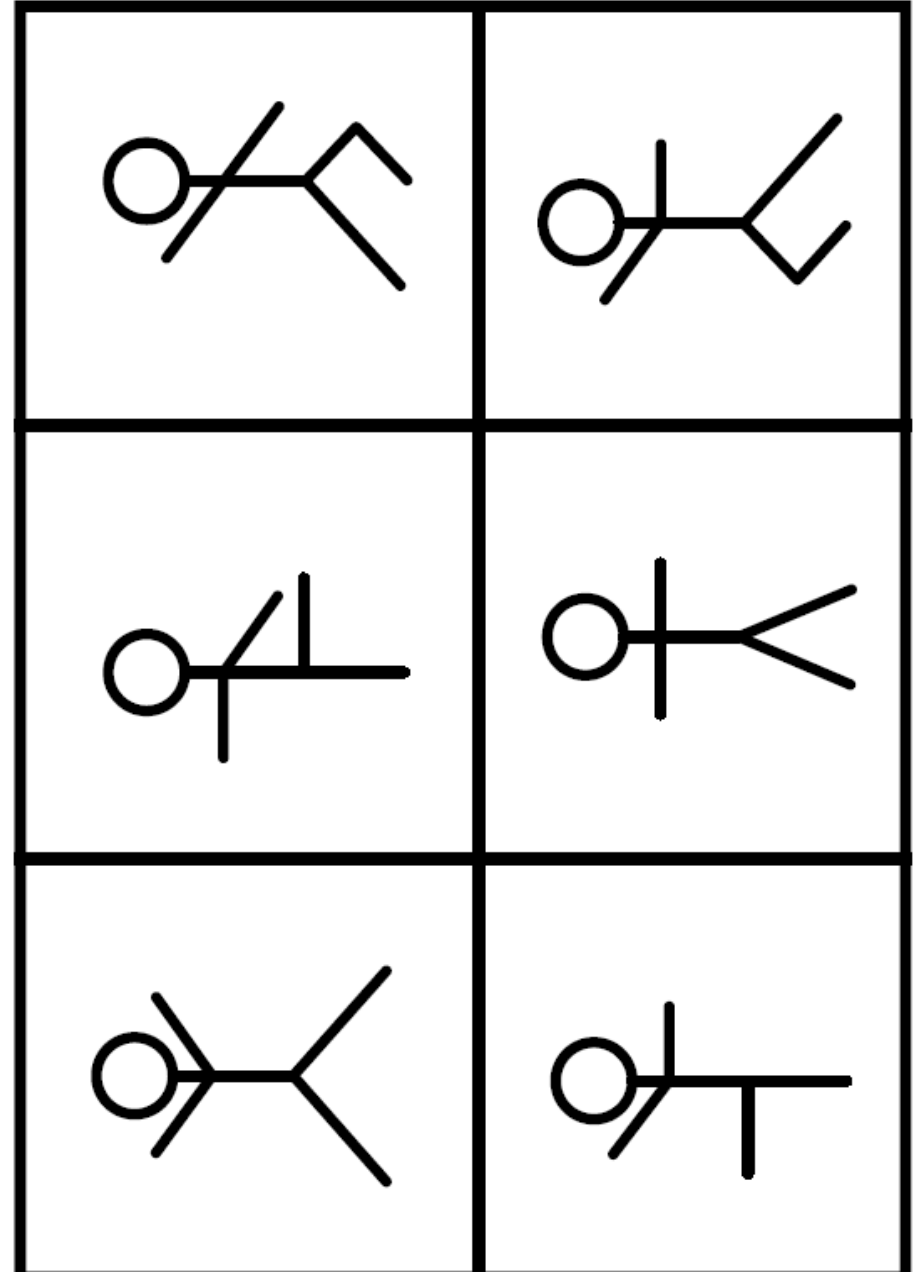
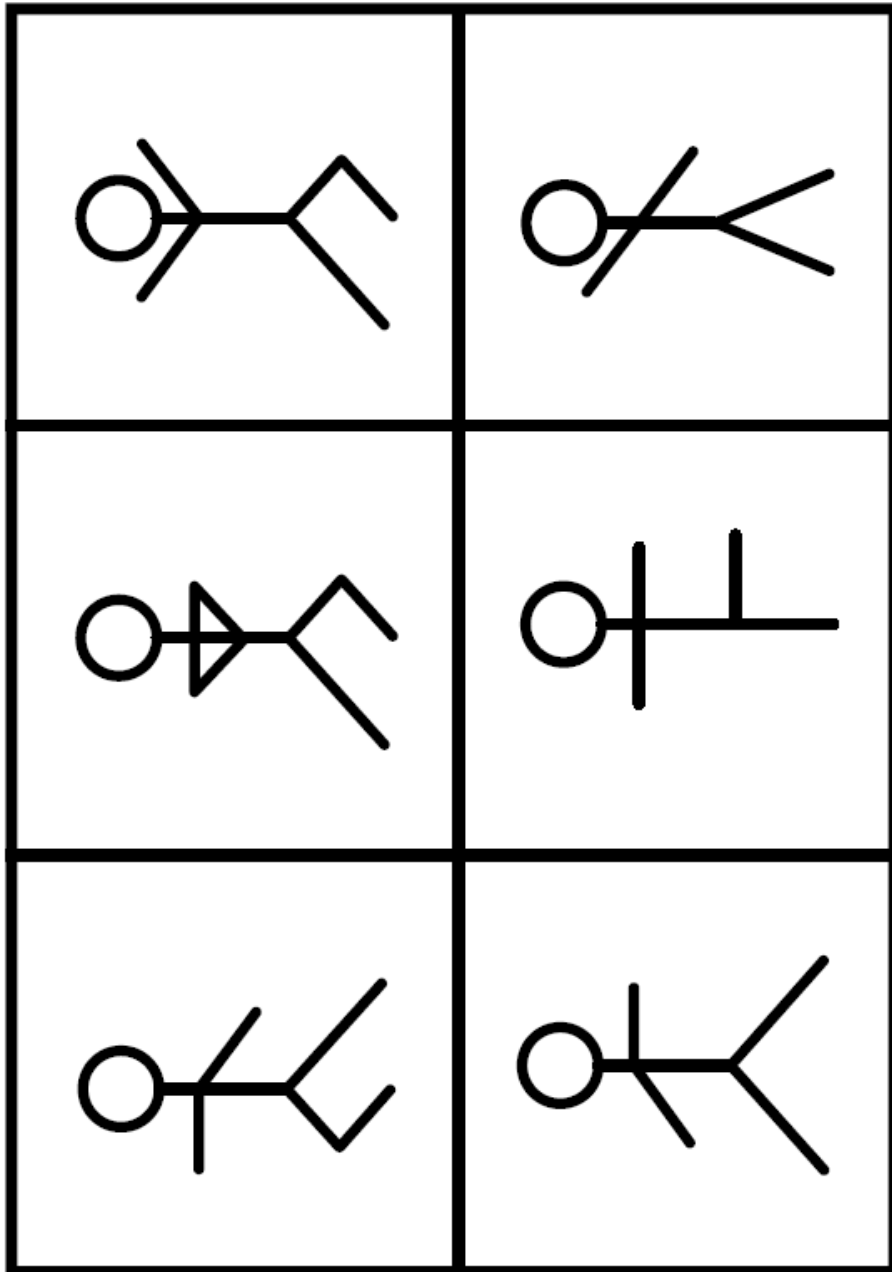
Have each player change their board and repeat the game - as many times as they wish.

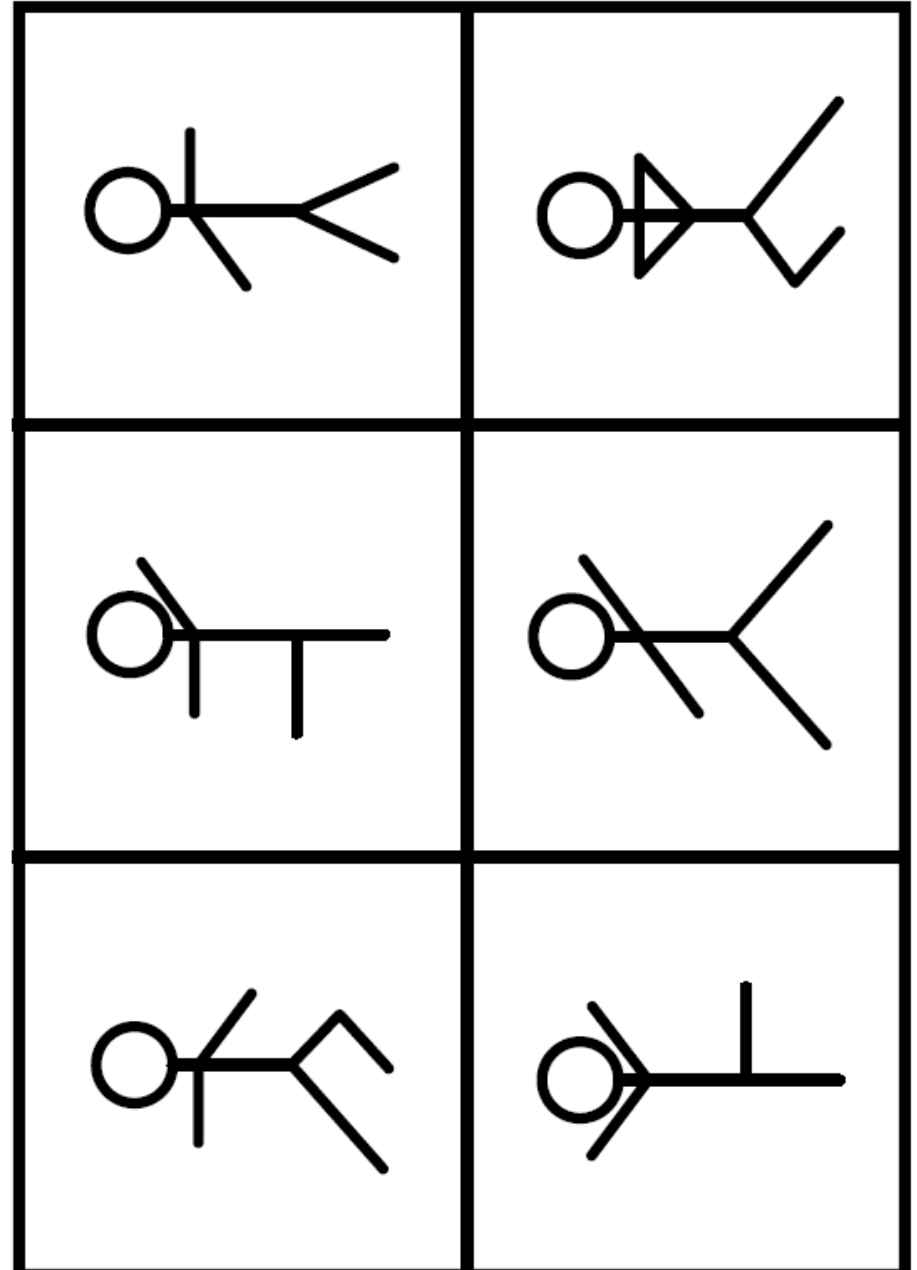
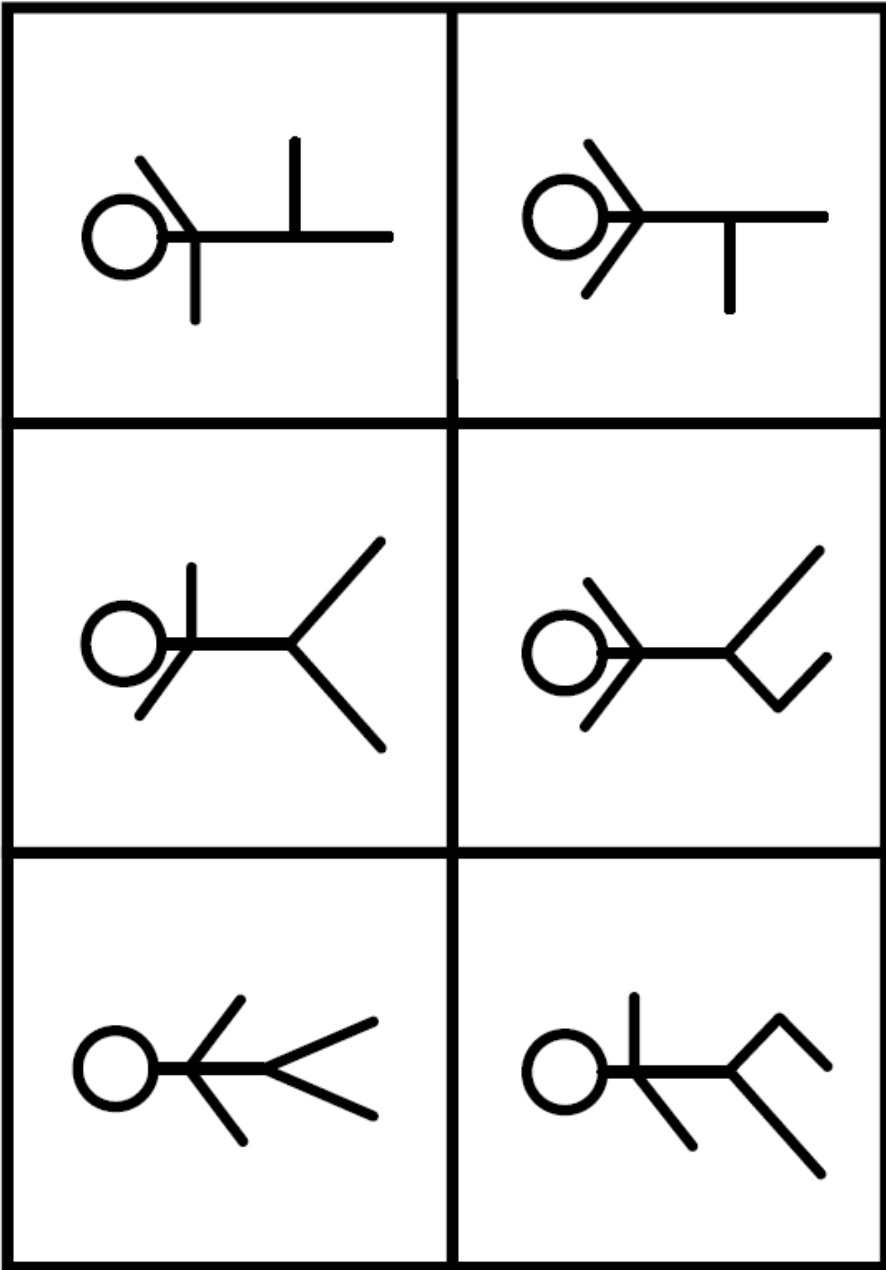


Your child can match real life pictures to their schematic representations.

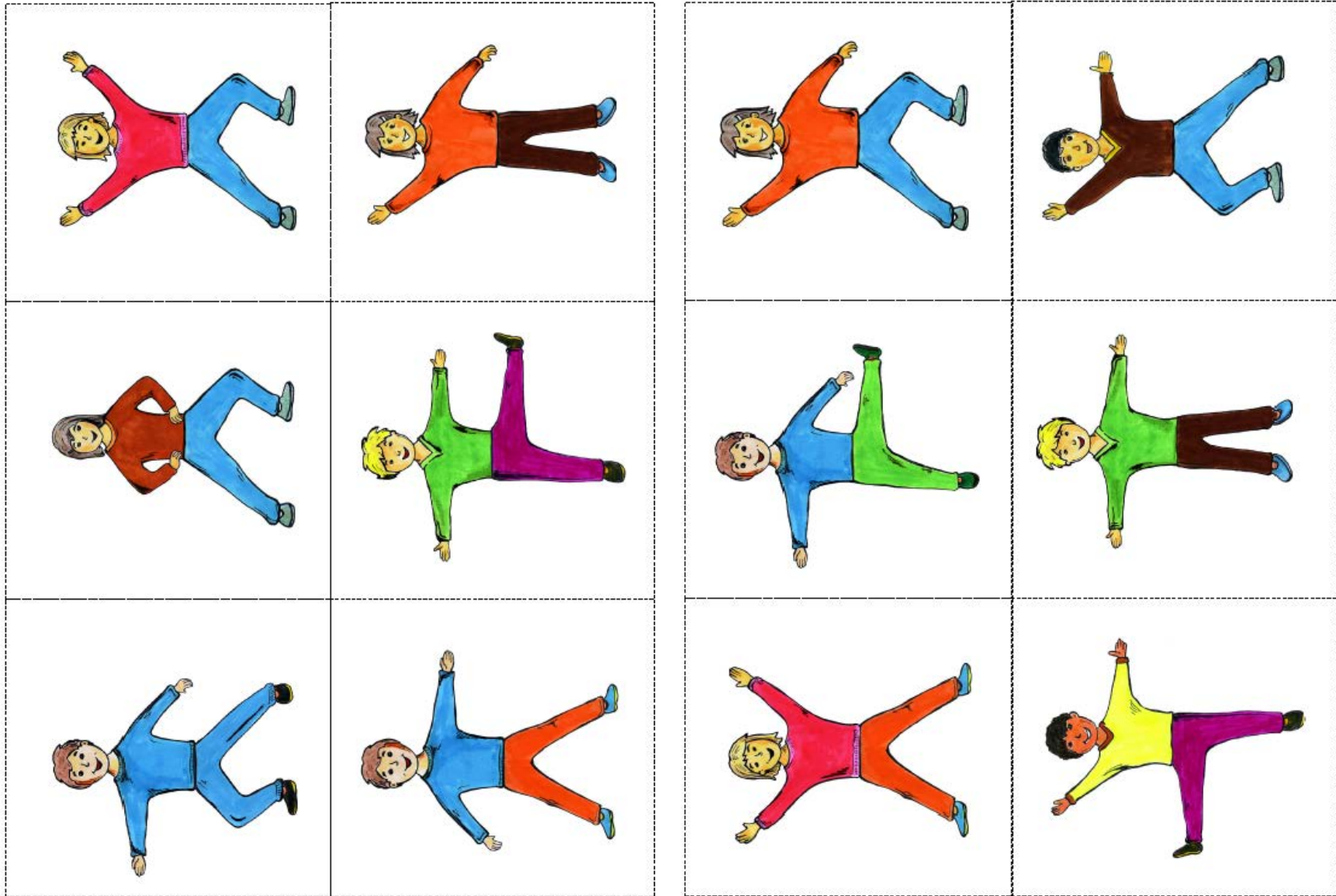
